

Spring Run Huskies Cheerleading Information 2009

Practice will begin on:

July 13th Practices will be every Monday and Wednesday from 6:00-8:00 p.m. at Spring Run - each team will have a designated area outside.

October

*All squads will be going inside to the gym/cafeteria. Please be aware that practice times may be adjusted due to darkness and to accommodate all the squads as they will not all fit in the gym/cafeteria at one time.

**For competition cheerleaders, coaches may be adding a Sunday practice in September, along with Monday and Wednesday evening if they feel the girls need extra practice time.

**** Parents are not allowed to stay for practice. ****

Cheerleading Camp: Spring Run will participate in TWO camps this season:

7/18/09 - at CES - stunt clinic. Each squad will have 2 hours beginning with flags at 9:00 a.m. More information will be given out the first week of practice.

8/1/09 - location and time TBA - this is the CCL camp which will be lead by Edge (collegiate level cheerleaders) and will be a full day.

PLEASE MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO ATTEND BOTH CAMPS. IT IS VERY HARD FOR GIRLS TO LEARN NEW STUNTS/ROUTINES IF GIRLS ARE MISSING. IF YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO ATTEND CAMP, PLEASE LET YOUR COACH OR DIRECTOR KNOW IMMEDIATELY.

Competitions:

CCL Flag Exhibition (November) (**Flag only Ages 5-7**) - **THERE IS A SPECTATOR FEE**

CCL Spectacular Competition Divisional (November) (**Ages 8-14**) - **THERE IS A SPECTATOR FEE**

2 or 3 additional competitions for all squads to be determined - CES (October), County Battle

(October), State or National Competition (November) - **THERE ARE SPECTATOR FEES FOR EACH OF THESE COMPETITIONS**

Fundraising:

THIS IS MANDATORY. In order to keep fees down (they have not been changed in the last two years although camp fees and competition fees have increased) and to give every girl who wants to cheer the opportunity to do so, it is necessary for each child to participate in fundraising. We will be using our fundraising monies to help pay the additional camp and competitions fees **PLUS** purchase warm ups for new cheerleaders, and for all cheerleaders body suits and lollies.

Fundraising monies also pay for homecoming gifts and trophies. If enough money is raised, we may be able to also purchase competition bows, etc. to save parents even more. Fundraising information will be sent out the first week of practice. If you would rather opt-out of fundraising, please see me for the opt-out fee.

For your child's safety - this pertains to camp, practices, and games:

- 1 Please make sure your child understands that they are never to leave with anyone.
- 2 Please do not leave your child without your child's head coach or assistant coaches knowing.

- 3 If someone other than parents will be picking up your child, make sure your child's coaches are aware of this.
- 4 If your child's coaches are not notified of someone other than the parents picking up the child, your child will not be permitted to leave and will remain there with their coaches, **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- 5 Make sure your coaches have your correct and current telephone numbers, including cell phone numbers.
